*Next week, please make plans to join the Youth Mission Team for a delicious Pancake Breakfast in the parish hall after all the morning masses. The teens and their parents will be preparing the meal as a way to raise funds for their summer mission trip to Cortez, Colorado.*

Please excuse the commercialism of this week's *From the desk of* but I am excited that the Aquinas Newman Center is sponsoring a mission trip for High School students this year.

On July 4th, nine teens (Rebecca Brunson, John Garrity, Adam Molley, Brian Molley, Kevin Schafer, Rebecca Schoeny, Mirinisa Stewart-Tengco, Maddie Velarde, & Marley Weig-Pickering) and two adults (Jude Fournier & Angie Schafer) will travel to Cortez, Colorado, for a week of Christian outreach. For half of the week, they will be helping residents paint and repair their homes, providing safe shelter and restoring their dignity. The other half of the week they will be teaching Vacation Bible School to the children in the community. They will be working with students from Christian churches throughout the United States. They will sleep on the floor of a church or school without electronics, music, phones, or other comforts of home. Their routine will mirror those who struggle in life without convenient showers, air conditioning, or readily available cold water. In short, the mission trip will expose them to a world, an existence, and a way of life that most have never seen.

Starting with next Sunday's pancake breakfast they will be working together, forming community, and becoming friends. They have planned a series of events to raise awareness and funds so that their trip is truly earned and not just given to them.

We have placed their pictures in the Gathering Space, for those who may not recognize the names. Please join with me to celebrate their commitment to living their Catholic faith and support in their endeavors to raise the necessary funds for their mission.

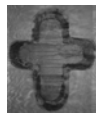
